

Official Public Records of Real Property of Harris County, Texas
is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Section 7 of Article VIII of the Restrictions which provides that a Living Unit shall not be less than five (5) feet from the Living Unit or appurtenant structure on any contiguous lot is hereby amended to provide that with respect to Lots 3, 11, 21, 26, 39, 42, 43, 45 and 46, all of Block 1, a Living Unit shall not be less than three (3) feet from the Living Unit or appurtenant structure on any contiguous Lot.

2. Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 3 of the First Amendment are hereby deleted in their entirety.

3. Section 11 of Article VIII of the Restrictions is amended and restated to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 11. Driveways: Each Lot shall have driveway access either to the street on which the Living Unit constructed thereon faces or to a street on which it may side. The Owner of each Lot shall construct and maintain at his expense a driveway from his garage to an abutting street, including the portion of the street right-of-way."

The last sentence of Section 11 as it read prior to the foregoing amendment is hereby deleted in its entirety.

4. Section 4 of Article VI of the Restrictions, as amended by the First Amendment, is hereby further amended to provide that the duties and powers of the members of the Committee shall cease on and after January 1, 1984, rather than January 1, 1983 or June 30, 1984, although the members of the Committee may voluntarily transfer all of their duties and powers prior to January 1, 1984 as set forth in such section.

5. Section 1 of Article VI of the Restrictions is hereby amended to reflect that as of the date of this Second Amendment the Committee is composed of Nicholas J. Palermo, Richard Chamberlain, and _____, the resignation of Samuel F. Marshall having been accepted on this date by Nicholas J. Palermo and Richard Chamberlain, the remaining two members of the Committee, and _____ having been appointed as the successor of Samuel F. Marshall.

6. Section 9 of Article VIII of the Restrictions is hereby amended to delete the following language: "unless otherwise approved by the Committee".

7. It has come to the attention of the undersigned that certain homes completed or presently under construction in the Subdivision may be in violation of the five (5) foot spacing requirement contained in Section 7 of Article VIII of the Restrictions, the masonry requirement of Section 6 of such Article VIII, and the sixty (60) foot garage set back requirement of Section 11 of such Article as it read prior to the First Amendment and this Second Amendment. To the extent any homes presently completed or presently under construction in the Subdivision violate Section 6, Section 7 or Section 11 of Article VIII of the Restrictions, the Restrictions shall be deemed modified to the extent, but only insofar as is necessary, to remove such existing homes from the requirement imposed by the particular restriction or restrictions violated. Nothing contained in this paragraph shall be deemed to be a waiver or release of any home of which construction is hereafter commenced from the requirements of the Restrictions, as amended by the First Amendment or hereby.

8. In the event any portion of this Second Amendment is ever determined to be invalid, the parties hereto hereby evidence their intent that all remaining provisions shall be binding as if such invalid provision had not been contained herein.

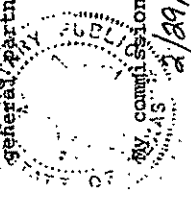

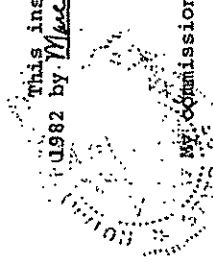


